RE: Administrative Policy Requiring Village Employees and Visitors to wear facial coverings within Village Buildings

Dear Village Residents and Employees:

We have recently seen a rise in COVID-19 cases across our community and the country as a result of the Delta variant. Consequently, on July 27, 2021, the CDC issued updated guidance to assist local decision makers in developing COVID-19 strategies to prevent the spread of the highly transmissible Delta variant.

Furthermore, the updated CDC guidance recommends implementing the following strategies to prevent the spread of COVID-19: (1) All unvaccinated persons wear facial coverings in public indoor settings; and (2) based on emerging evidence on the Delta variant that fully vaccinated persons wear facial coverings in public indoor settings in areas of substantial or high transmission. Currently, all of Miami Dade County is an area of substantial or high transmission.

Accordingly, after careful review and consideration, to maximize protection from the Delta variant and prevent the possible spread to others, I am instituting an administrative policy requiring facial coverings at all indoor Village facilities for employees and for visitors. Upon request, the Village will work with individuals unable to comply with this policy to ensure access to essential government services. This administrative policy supersedes all previous policies relating to facial coverings at Village facilities.

The health and safety of our community remains a top priority, and we will continue to do our best to maintain a healthy Village and work environment.
